The following criteria must be met for transfer students:

1. UGA transfer students are not eligible for first semester entry and must follow transfer admission procedures.
2. Transfer students must have earned a minimum of 30-hours of graded academic credits.
3. Transfer students must have earned a minimum of 3.75 cumulative GPA.
4. Transfer students are required to meet the Honors Program application deadline for consideration.

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II. Letter of Recommendation

Please include the following letter of recommendation in sealed and signed envelope with your application packet.

A. A letter from a faculty member at your current institution. The letter should reflect your academic abilities and provide insight into ways you can contribute to the Honors Program.

or

B. If you are currently enrolled in an Honors Program/College, please include a letter from an administrator or faculty member in the program, preferably the Dean or Director. This letter should discuss your academic abilities and contributions to the program.

III. Official Transcripts

Please include an official transcript from your current institution and any other post-secondary institution that you have attended.

The transcript(s) must be in a sealed envelope from your current institution and any other post-secondary institution attended. If your institution requires the direct mailing of official documents, please indicate that the transcripts will arrive under separate cover.

IV. Academic Plan

Transfer students admitted to the Honors Program are required to complete nine Honors courses (including a minimum of three upper division courses) to graduate with Honors.

Please indicate the courses that you plan to take in order to satisfy the requirements to graduate with Honors. Students who have earned Honors credit in courses at their transfer institution may petition to receive Honors credit upon acceptance into the University of Georgia Honors Program.

Nine of the Honors courses must include at least three 3000 level or higher.

Transfer decisions will be determined after first year and first semester entry processes are completed, on a space available basis.***

Students accepted into the University of Georgia Honors Program are required to enroll in HONS 1000H: Introduction to Honors seminar. Failure to enroll and complete the HONS 1000H course during the Fall 2012 semester will result in dismissal from the program.
