The Pre-Professional Advising Office (https://ppao.uga.edu/) serves UGA students interested in healthcare careers as doctors, dentists, optometrists, physician's assistants; those in the allied-health fields (physical therapists, occupational therapists, anesthesiologist assistants, and genetic counselors); and nursing. Pre-professional advisors are not academic advisors (i.e., they will not clear your registration holds). They instead work with you to help you ready yourself for the advanced work required by your field. What's the best major for pre-health?

Pre-Medical, Pre-Dental, Pre-Physician Associate, etc. are not majors at UGA. There is no best major for any of the healthcare professions, nor are there any majors that will make a student standout when applying to health professional schools. Students are encouraged to select majors which they find genuinely interesting and to take required pre-requisites alongside their major coursework.

What is the suggested pre-medical course sequence?

MCAT CONTENT	RECOMMENDED COURSES
Biological & Biochemical	BIOL 1107/L & BIOL 1108/L; Physiology (VPHY 3100, PMCY 3000, CBIO
Foundations of Living Systems	3710 or CBIO 2200 and 2210); BCMB 3100 (BCMB 4010 & 4020 for BCMB Majors)
Chemical and Physical	CHEM 1211/L & CHEM 1212/L; CHEM 2211/L; BCMB 3100
Foundations of Biological	(BCMB 4010 & 4020 for BCMB Majors); PHYS 1111 & PHYS 1112 (PHYS 1211
Systems	& PHYS 1212 can be taken); STAT 2000 or BIOS 2010

What is a sample pre-medical schedule of required courses?

** Organic Chemistry 2 is required by most medical schools for admission and ideally there should be no gap between Organic Chemistry 1 and Organic Chemistry 2

Do medical schools accept AP credit?

Medical schools generally do not accept AP credit, although AP credit acceptance varies at each school. All programs are different and their requirements can change, so make sure to research your preferred programs to find out exactly what they will and will not accept.

Are the pre-requisites the same for dental, optometry, and PA school?

While the pre-dental, pre-optometry, and pre-physician assistant tracks are similar to premedical, there are some differences (i.e., pre-dental students do not need to take physics before the DAT and pre-physician assistant students need three, rather than four semesters of chemistry). Make an appointment with the appropriate pre-health advisor in the fall or spring to confirm your particular field's requirements.
